Teacher's comments:	The children really enjoyed the topic. Some pupils were judged to be emerging because the topic was new to them, they were a young cohort and some were EAL. They needed a lot of prompting for appropriate language. Some pupils were working at expected level because they recognised and named some of the symbols.
