Context: <i>Description of task</i>	Mock Baptism with priest costume for children. Dressing up with a sense of occasion. Role play. Rehearsed key vocab beforehand. Children set up the baptism themselves with the symbols. This was done in groups.
Level of support provided	<div>None Minimal Moderate</div> <div>High</div> <p>This was differentiated depending on the set of children. If child had low level of support, they could visit another group for reinforcement.</p>

<i>Resources used to support task</i>	Symbols of baptism. Costumes for priest and fancy clothes for sense of occasion.
Teacher's comments:	<p>Key vocabulary as laid out in Come and See.</p> <p>The children were able to show an understanding of what was happening.</p> <p>I would expect most children to be able to say "I baptise you in the name of the Father....."</p> <p>A higher ability child said " We light the baptismal candle to show us Jesus is the light of the world"</p>

Reception – Baptism Assessment

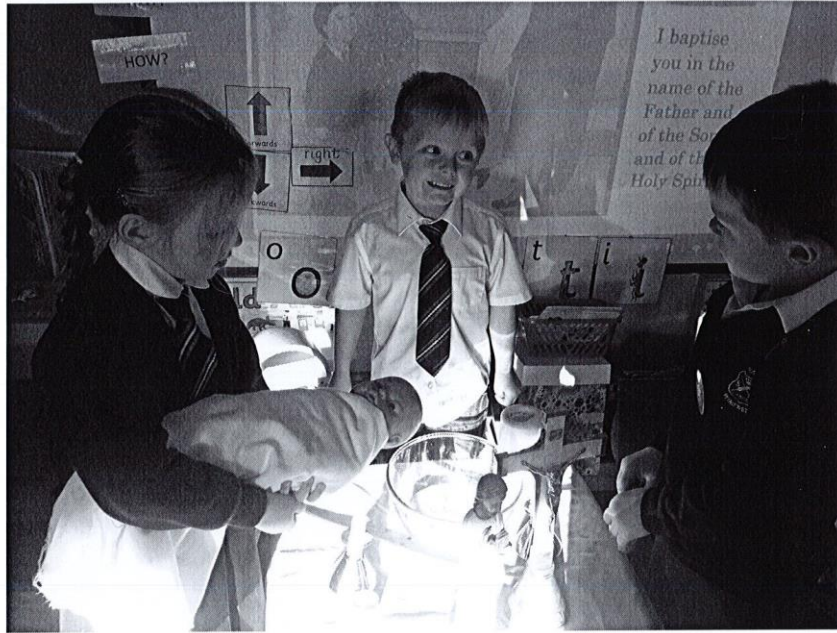


Ollie (centre) said "We are samarising the baby." He corrected it to baptising when I gave him the initial sound.

He knew that we were welcoming the baby into God's family.

He poured water over the baby's head saying, "I baptise you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit Amen."

Ollie had a good level of understanding.



Rio (left of picture) said we were washing the baby's head. When I asked why we were doing this he said, "The baby's head is dirty." He did not understand that we were welcoming the baby.

When it was his turn he did pour water over the baby's head and say, "I baptise you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit Amen."

Rio had limited understanding of Baptism.



Owen (centre) did not know the name of the sacrament but with prompting and referring to the picture on the board he was able to say that we were welcoming the baby.

When it was his turn he did pour water over the baby's head and say, "I baptise you in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit Amen."

Owen is at the expected level.

RE Assessment

Knowledge and understanding

- Explore – what it is to be welcomed

- Discuss the picture from Gods story page 69 naming the different people and objects.
- Reinact the baptism of a baby through role play using key vocabulary and making the sign of the cross

Ruby 21/11/18

During our baptism role play, Ruby was able to recognise and name the priest 'He's doing a prayer with the Holy water.'

Marcel offered no contributions even with prompting - see below.

Sienna 21/11/18

Sienna was able to name the people correctly in the picture when we were discussing baptism "Priest, mummy and Daddy" - During our role play Sienna told me we are baptised 'to be the family of the son of God.' Sienna told me we light the baptism candle because... "it reminds us that Jesus is the light of the ~~our~~ world. After our pretend baptism Sienna said 'I was baptised when I was a baby.'

Liam 21/11/18

During our baptism role play Liam pointed to the picture and said 'that's God' pointing to the priest. We talked about God's special helpers and the role of priests. I asked Liam 'where is God?' 'in the world all around us' Liam said.

Megan 21/11/18

During our baptism Role play Megan played the part of the priest. She blessed the baby saying the sign of the cross and was able to name the Godparents in the picture.



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Group *Mae, Coral, Ed, Joseph Mukaed*

Ed 21/11/18

During a discussion about baptism we looked at a picture of a baby being baptised. That's Jesus' Ed pointed to the baby. 'This is God' points to Godparent. We act out the baptism of the baby. Ed played the part of the Godfather.

We talked about each persons role and Gods presence. When our 'priest' began to pour the bless the baby Ed said 'He's putting the Holy water on his head and doing the sign of the cross.'

Coral 21/11/18

Coral was able to name the mummy, Daddy, brothers and the picture of the baby being baptised. Coral was unsure of the priest or Godparents. We acted out baptising our baby. I want to be the mum, I want to hold

the baby' Coral said. Joseph dressed as the priest. Who is Joseph I asked 'Priest', 'where is God?' I asked 'In Heaven' Coral said.

Mae 21/11/18

During a discussion about Baptism we looked at a picture of a baby being baptised. Mae named the mummy, daddy, brothers and baby. Mae couldn't name the priest but when I asked what he was doing she said 'putting sign of the cross water whilst making the sign'.

Another child said 'theres Jesus and pointed to the baby. No, thats the baby' Mae corrected. I asked why we light the Easter candle for Jesus mae said. Mae was unsure where Baptisms took place or the role of the Godparents so we talked about that together.

Joseph 21/11/18

During our Discussion about baptism we looked at a picture of a baby being baptised. Joseph named the mummy, Daddy and priest. We acted out a baptism. Joseph was the priest. He blessed the baby and said 'in the name of the father & of the son and of the Holy Spirit' when I asked why we light the candle Joseph said 'God!', the world. - God is the light of the world I said 'Yeah' Joseph nodded.
