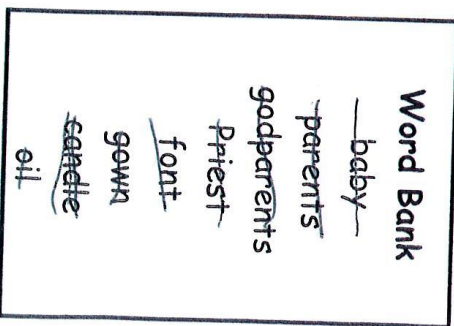

What is it?	Picture
Baptismal candle	 <p>The candle is to show the baby to be saved.</p>
White Garment	 <p>A white garment for the baby's special day.</p>
Oil of Chrism	 <p>Oil of the priest to put on the baby's head.</p>
Water	 <p>Holy water - the priest pours water on the baby's head 3 times.</p>
