Teacher's comments:	The child recognises the baptismal candle as a symbol of baptism. They could also recognise other symbols of baptism.



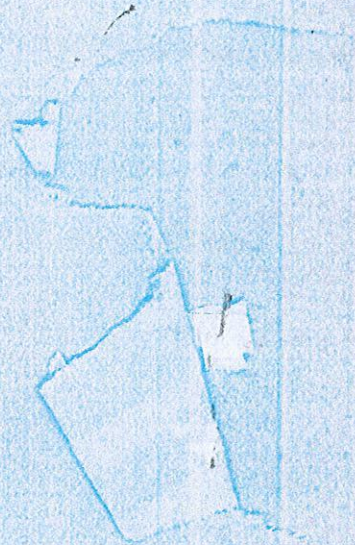
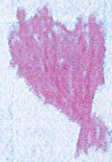
