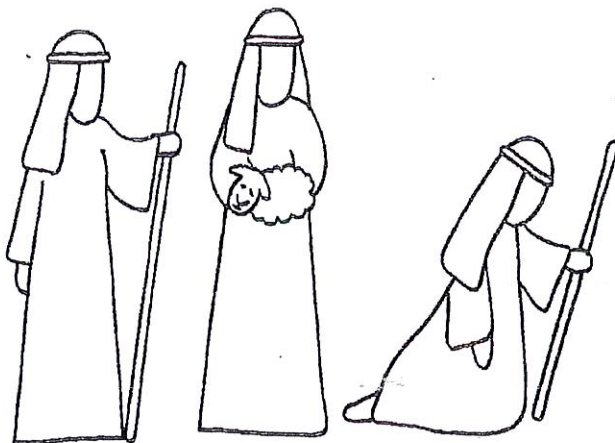
On the way to Bethlehem Joseph was tired because he was walking and it was cold too.



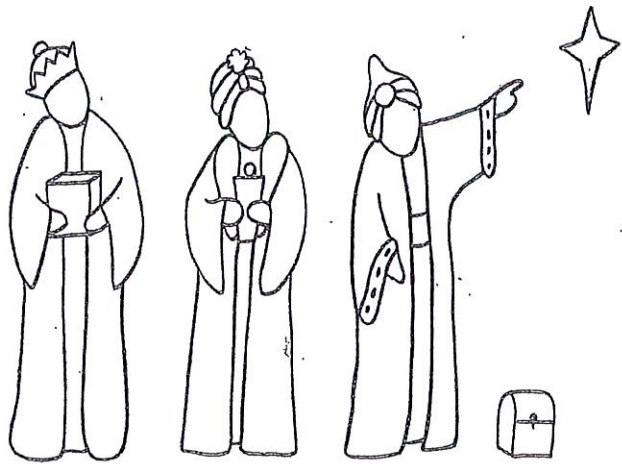
The next day Joseph went to all the inn's and they were full but one inn keeper said "You can go into the stable with all the animals."
