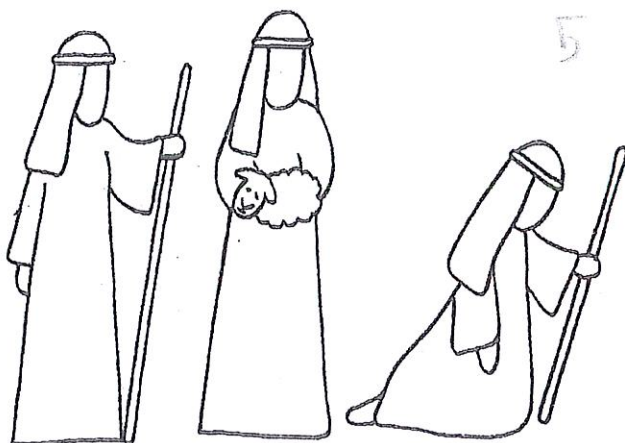
2. Then Mary and Joseph traveled for many days then they reached Bethlehem.



When they reached Bethlehem but the houses were full until they found a stable and went to it.

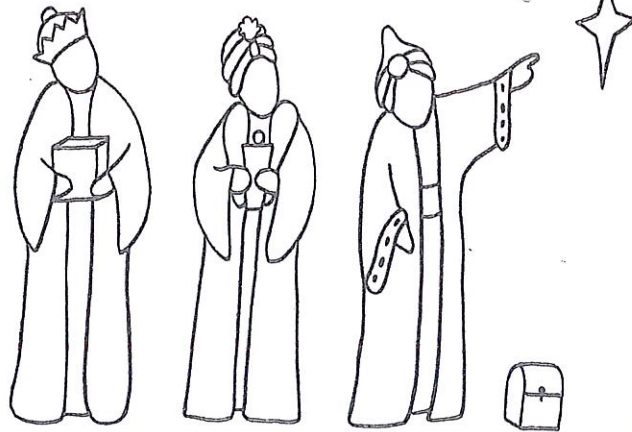


When Mary and Joseph reached the stable Mary gave birth to baby Jesus they were very happy.
