# Ordination Orders!

This is about the Ordination of how men over the age of eighteen become priests. The Ordination is a very special type of Mass! Where men think that God is calling them to become a priest!



## The calling!

When a man feels that God is calling him to be a priest, he will need to be trained by another priest to see if he actually thinks God is calling him and if he is serious on taking on such a great responsibility.

## Holy Orders.









At the ending of his training, if the man shows that he is ready to become a priest, the Bishop will decide to accept him. He will need to pray a lot! and communicate the good news and serve the parish.

## Gospel.

After the Gospel is read by the Bishop, he will ask the man to step up to the front, to lie down, and they will sing litany, which is a special type of prayer.

The laying of the hands  
After they sing the litany, the man kneels down in front of the Bishop and he lays his hand on the man's head and says a special prayer in his head.
