

As best practice is that those inducted into new leadership roles are provided with mentors, the programme begins with an induction session for chairs of governors and briefing for mentors, exploring the programme content and delivery and the wider mentoring pathway for new Heads. Those new to headship are equipped to form a professional network within our Diocesan family of schools, which enables them to flourish. A range of speakers from various schools complement the programme and enable sharing of best and next practice.
