





Holy Hour to Launch Stage 4 of Hope in the Future

'Proclaiming the Good News' Sunday 3rd October 2021, 3:00pm The following is offered as a suggested structure for a Holy Hour to launch Stage 4 of Hope in the Future. Parishes may wish to adapt these resources to suit local needs and resources. Parishes may wish to invite families and school communities to contribute to this time of prayer. The suggested time for the Holy Hour is 3:00pm, however you may prefer a different time or choose to launch Stage 4 as part of the weekend Masses by using some of the elements below, for example, the reflections, prayers, specific intercessions, and the commissioning service.

Introduction

As we gather today, let us listen to the invitation from Pope Francis to enter into a closer relationship with Christ.

I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them; I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day. No one should think that this invitation is not meant for him or her, since "no one is excluded from the joy brought by the Lord" (*Evangelii Gaudium* 3)

Reflections

Let us reflect on recent Church documents on the Mission of the Church and ask Jesus to send his Holy Spirit to give us a passion for sharing his Good News with others:

Evangelising is in fact the grace and vocation proper to the Church, her deepest identity. She exists in order to evangelise (EN14)

- Is evangelisation a priority in my life and parish?

In virtue of their baptism, all the members of the People of God have become missionary disciples. All the baptised, whatever their position in the Church or their level of instruction in the faith, are agents of evangelisation. (EG 20)

- Do I see myself as a Missionary Disciple and ambassador for Jesus?

I dream of a "missionary option", that is, a missionary impulse capable of transforming everything, so that the Church's customs, ways of doing things, times and schedules, language and structures can be suitably channelled for the evangelization of today's world rather than for her self-preservation. (EG 27)

- Am I excited by Pope Francis' vision for the Church?

We become fully human when we become more than human, when we let God bring us beyond ourselves in order to attain the fullest truth of our being. Here we find the source and inspiration of all our efforts at evangelization. For if we have received the love which restores meaning to our lives, how can we fail to share that love with others? (EG 8)

- What difference has Faith made in my life? What is stopping me from sharing it with others?

It must be said that the Holy Spirit is the principal agent of evangelization: it is he who impels each individual to proclaim the Gospel, and it is he who in the depth of consciences causes the word of salvation to be accepted and understood (EN 75)

- Am I truly open to the Holy Spirit working through me?

There is nothing more beautiful than to be surprised by the Gospel, by the encounter with Christ. There is nothing more beautiful than to know Him and to speak to others of our friendship with Him. (Pope Benedict)

- Lord, who do you want me to share you with today?
