






Please keep them coming!


We also have certificates for pupils. If you email us with what they have done (any kind of local social action) and what the impact has been - they will get a certificate for them or their class.

Advocacy and campaigning



We are currently focusing on our summer campaign - 302,158 children are living in poverty in the Diocese of Salford.

Our director Patrick O'dowd has called for changes to policies that support real families who need help immediately, for example by ending the two-child limit on benefits, increasing the number of children with access to free school meals, encouraging employers to pay the real living wage, and addressing other issues at the root cause of poverty.

We have also joined the End Child Poverty Coalition, and are supporting their work.



Caritas Schools Service

Social workers, counsellors and art therapy based in schools across the Diocese and beyond....

Last year we supported around 40 schools across the Diocese and as far as Macclesfield, Preston and Burnley and across GMP with our workers going into schools and lots of doing direct work with children.

Our service support children for as long as they need-with the agreement of the school- and there are around 25% of children referred who need longer time to build the relationships with their workers to articulate themselves and to achieve changes.

The main difficulties appear to involve children's anxiety and 'getting back to normal'; there are more complex and difficult areas of parental separation, domestic abuse and, sometimes, less resilience from families too.

We find that there are more demands on school staff in approaching safeguarding needs. Our workers are confident in supporting schools here and we have found that social workers are spending more of their time supporting schools with fuller exploration of information or with referrals to relevant agencies.

All our team- social workers and counsellors and art therapists feel confident working with families as well as children.

We also support school staff who can access counselling as well as the children/young people.

Why not explore how Caritas Schools Service can help? We have some capacity for flexible sessions and drop-ins in September and October.


