Will speak in your heart

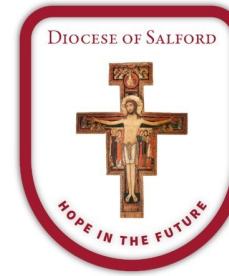


### Diocesan Youth Prayer

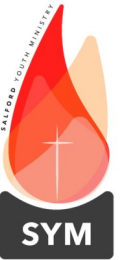
